American Tall Tales by Adrien Stoutenburg, for example
- **A Book Written or Set in Ancient Greece or Rome**
- **A Mystery or Detective Novel**
Anything from Encyclopedia Brown to Dorothy L. Sayers
- **A Legend**
Such as King Arthur or Robin Hood; Rosemary Sutcliff has written many books in this genre.
- **A Shakespeare Play**
Or a retelling of a Shakespeare play
